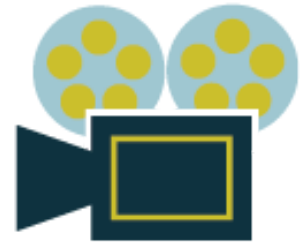

## **SOME NEED TO KNOW STUFF**

Use whatever equipment you can get your hands on.

High tech gear is not the most important thing. You could use a phone or a tablet/ipad. But remember that **sound is really important** too so do a test first. There's lots of help available on the internet. A simple search such as "How do I record good sound on an IPAD" - can provide lots of advice.

There are also lots of free easy to use editing applications to help you make your film awesome. Depending on what computer/tablet or ipad you're using search for some options. i.e What's a free and easy video editing app for windows? Or Android? or Apple? etc.

## **DO YOU HAVE PERMISSION**

The following forms are necessary to allow us to show your film on a big screen in front of an audience. For a copy of these forms or for any questions about the competition you can download them at <http://maorilandfilm.co.nz/resources-for-rangatahi-filmmakers/>

It's very very important that you have permission from all of the people who appear in your film. This is called a "Talent Release Form".

You will also need to show us a Location Release Form that shows you had permission to film in a private place like someone's home or public place like a supermarket/school/library.

Last but not least - you will also need a release to use music in your film. There is lots of free music online - search 'royalty free music' or 'free music for YouTube'.
