

KAITIAKI PARA KORE

JOB DESCRIPTION

During the five days of the Māoriland Film Festival, the population of Ōtaki doubles in size. That's more than 12000 people attending our screenings and events. Māoriland Film Festival wants to ensure that the impact on our beautiful whenua is as light as possible. Therefore we initiating a Para Kore trial at MFF2020 as we aim towards becoming a zero waste event.

We are looking for an enthusiastic hands on person who is passionate about waste minimisation to deliver our Para Kore project. This is a significant paid role that will require an excellent communicator and team leader. The Māoriland Pare Kore co-ordinator will be responsible for managing a team of volunteers and communicating these efforts in real time to our community and festival visitors.

KEY OBJECTIVES:

- Managing the Para Kore space at the Māoriland Hub
- Placement of our Pare Kore bin stations in Main Street, Ōtaki Village
- Daily monitoring and collection of all bins at Māoriland Hub, alternative waste bins
- Supervising the sorting, washing & composting at the Para Kore space, Māoriland Hub
- Helping find a team kaitūao (volunteers) and their supervision during MFF2020
- Collection and reporting of key measurable data throughout the festival week
- Remove sorted recyclable materials and waste from the Māoriland Hub (if necessary) to local recycling centre.
- Clean up/Pack down at the Māoriland Hub post festival.

This role is an evolving project and new tasks may occur throughout the festival week. We need someone who can think on their feet, is adaptable and up for the challenge of the festival!
